

Packing Tips From the Pros

Place small boxes in a single large box, filling in spaces with crushed paper.



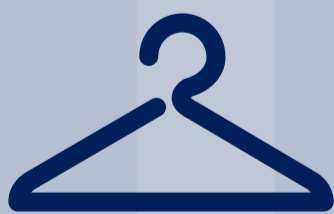
The more fragile the item, the more cushioning needed.

Wind electrical cords, fastening them so they do not dangle.



Begin by packing out-of-season items and then pack things used infrequently.

Avoid overloading cartons. The carton should close easily without force.



Remove light bulbs before packing your lamps.
